PTA LEGISLATION COMMITTEE CONTRACT STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

Students are required to attend monthly meetings that are held during scheduled class time. The meetings are held at The Fran Greenspan Administration Center, 525 Half Hollow Road, Dix Hills or in the High Schools. All work missed in classes as a result of the meetings must be completed.

Students are required to arrive at the meetings on the school bus provided. It is unacceptable for a student to walk or drive to the Fran Greenspan Administration Center.

Students are required to be dressed appropriately for all meetings and conduct themselves in a business like manner. We never know when we may host a special guest at any given meeting. Students must be respectful of all committee members and not be disruptive or speak at inappropriate times. Everyone will be encouraged to become PTSA members, as they are active participants on this committee.

If a student can't attend a meeting or any of the events due to extenuating circumstances, he/she must telephone one of the committee chairpersons before being absent. Students are also required to respond to all emails sent out from the committee co-chairs.
